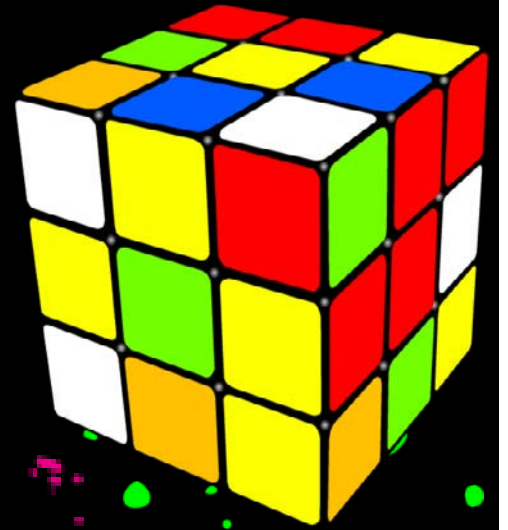
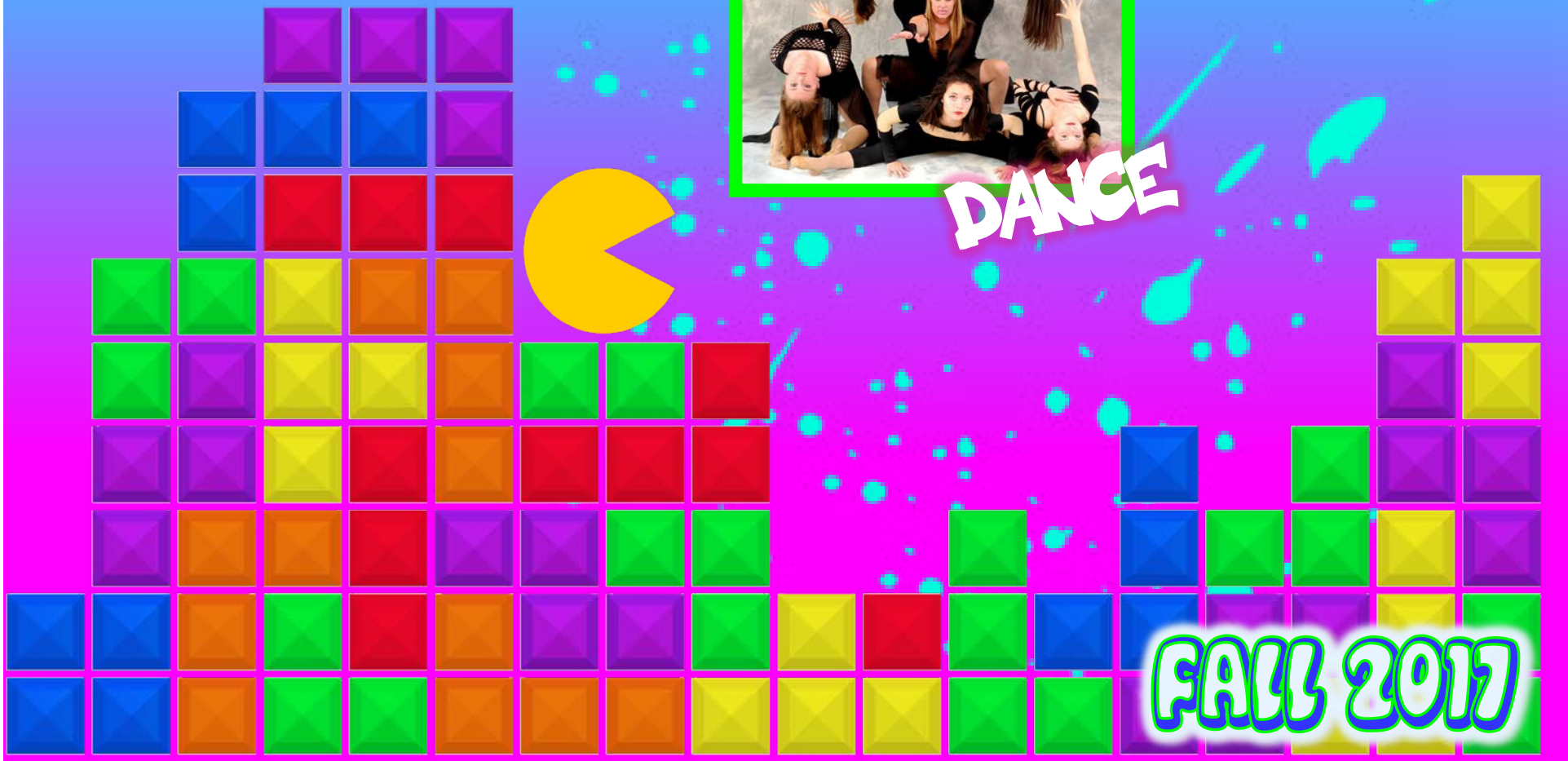

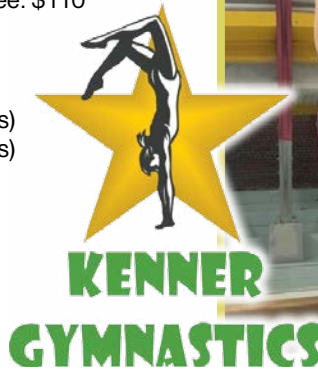
## GYMNASTICS - AGES 3-15

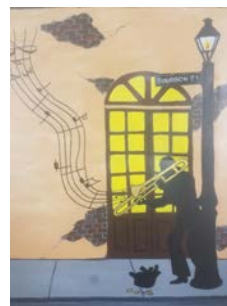
